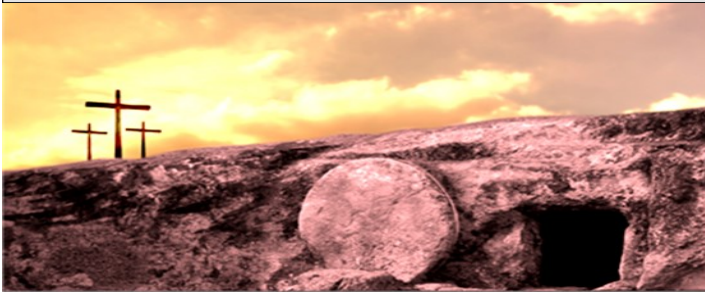

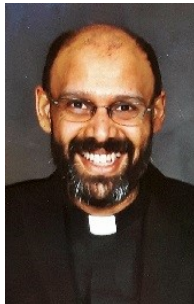
If someone were to ask you why Easter is so important how would you respond?

Our Father. Every barrier has been removed, and we can personally experience the love of God our heavenly Father. The resurrection of Jesus from the dead affirms that death is not the end. We are meant for more than this present life, we are not anchored to, or stuck in this world.

Human life is no longer limited by the cycle of birth to death. Easter is the answer to all the tears that we shed at the graves of our loved ones because it reminds us that we have a future greater than we dare believe in, provided we open our hearts to the grace that Jesus won for us. Christ has shared the gift of his life with us and his resurrection from the dead points to the resurrection of all people. Easter calls us out of the darkness, Easter calls us to celebrate the fact that the light of Christ has come into the darkness of our world providing us with hope for a future greater than we dare believe. As unbelievable as this may seem, we know that God is in charge – with God nothing is impossible. This is His world and He has decided to give us eternal life.
